


DISPLAY SCREEN & KEYPAD





NO.	NAME	DESCRIPTION
1.	Display Screen	This displays the options for each screen on the hand-held Body Module.
2.	Backspace	Exit back to the previous screen or back to the Main Menu*.
3.	Arrow Left	Move back one screen level
4.	Arrow Right	Move forward one screen level
5.	Arrow Down	Used to navigate to an individual item displayed on the Main Screen in both
6.	Arrow Up	the left and right sidebars.
7.	Select	Used in selecting a configuration. NOTE: This button has to be pressed whenever navigating configurations with button numbers 2-6 to execute any operation / configurations.


The operator will use the buttons on top of the hand-held body module to navigate to the different menu options. If there are special requirements for the use of a button in a menu, there will be instructions on that specific screen indicating the operation of the button. The Display Screen is NOT a touch screen application.

*To return back to the Main Menu screen, push the backspace button

as many times necessary.







When the IPU Chassis is selected, the IPU will be used to drive the hydraulic power for the crane and body functions, and will command hydraulic power when needed for the Crane, Stabilizers, and Compressor.

To start IPU:

- 1. Engage E-Brake.
- 2. Turn chassis ignition key to the "RUN" position.
- 3. Activate cab switch # 2.
- 4. Wait two seconds.
- 5. Chassis ignition can be turned from the "RUN" position, to the 'OFF" position. Ignition key can be removed.
- 6. Navigate to Crane Menu and turn on the crane.
- 7. IPU will be operational using the controls found in their stored compartment.
